



Information about avalanches

Disasters can easily occur when there is heavy snowfall. Be careful of the following things.

- 1 Snow that accumulates on mountains can suddenly break off, causing what is called an “avalanche.” Avoid roads with signs with avalanche or falling rock warnings. Be especially careful if lots of snow falls at once, or if the temperature rises quickly.
- 2 Please watch out for snow falling from roofs as it can easily cause injuries.
- 3 Please be careful of cars and other vehicles when removing snow off the side of the road. Also, when disposing of snow in irrigation ditches, please make sure that they do not overflow.
- 4 When removing snow from rooftops, in order to not fall, make sure to use a rope and have something to prevent you from slipping. Also, do not start working without notifying your family or neighbors, and do not do it alone. Please be careful on warmer or rainy days, as roofs can become extremely slippery.

There could be even more snowfall again at any moment. Please be extremely careful.
